CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1911, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

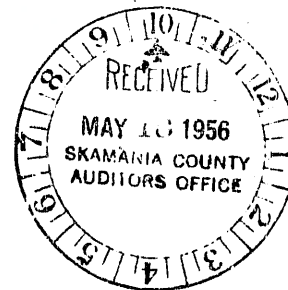
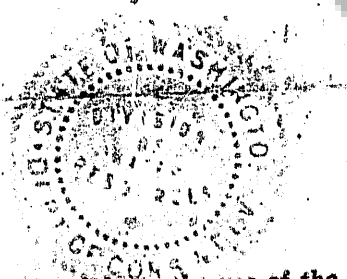
of Vancouver, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Wind River, a tributary of Columbia River, with point or points of diversion within the Government Lot 6, Sec. 7, Twp. 3 N., R. 8 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in Appropriation Permit No. 10121 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 13, at Page 6485, on the 11th day of May, 1956, that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is May 5, 1955; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually bene. ally used and shall not exceed

0.10 of a cubic foot per second for the purposes

of manufacturing a mill pond.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Beginning in the NE 1/4, sec. 7, marking the intersection of the center of the channel of Wind River with the right of way line of State Highway 8-C on the right of way line of suspension bridge over Wind River, thence following the right of way line of State Highway 8-C detour in a southerly direction, thence following State Highway 8-C detour in a generally westerly direction to intersection with the center of channel of Wind River, said point being on the right of way of existing water level bridge over Wind River, thence following the center of the channel of Wind River in an easterly direction to the point of beginning. Ten acres more or less.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
