B. O. Heaton to A. S. Boardman

Know all men by these presents: That we, B. O. Heaton and Barbara Heaton, his wife, of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar, to us in hand paid by A. S. Boardman, of the City of Vancouver, State of Washington, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said A. S. Boardman and to his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain real and personal property, situated, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All the down and standing timber now growing or being upon the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter, and the South half of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section Thirty-four (34), Township Two (2) North, Range Four (4) East of the Willamette Meridian. The said grantee and his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are hereby granted the full right and authority to enter into and upon the said land with his servants, agents, workmen and employees and cut down said timber and trees and to remove the same when, and as he or his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns shall think proper, any time within the period of ten (10) years or and after the date hereof.

And he is further granted the full right and authority to construct flumes, roadways, skidways, or any other means of transportation, requisite, necessary or convenient to carry and transfer the said timber when felled, or the products thereof from and off said land.

To have and to hold the above described premises unto the said A. S. Boardman, and to his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns. And we, the said grantors, do covenant to and with the said grantee, his heirs and assigns, that the above granted premises are free from all encumbrances, and that we have a good right to make the grant herein and hereby made, and that we will, and our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, shall warrant, and defend the title thereto and each part and parcel thereof.
