The Grantors for and in consideration of the sum of Fourteen hundred & 10/100 Dollars, in hand paid, convey and warrant to the Portland & Seattle Railway Company, a Washington corporation and its successors and assigns, the following described real estate situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, viz: A strip of land one hundred feet in width being fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of said Railway Company, as now located, staked out and to be constructed over and across that part of the S. M. Hamilton Donation Land claim, lying in Section nineteen (19) and Twenty (20) Township two (2) North Range Seven (7) East Willamette Meridian, including the preference right of the grantors herein to purchase the portion of said shore lands contained within said strip, said consideration also being in full settlement of all claims and demands for damage sustained by reason of the location, construction, maintenance and operation of said railroad, on, over and across said described land.

The Railway Company to provide private grade road crossings across said strip of land at two practicable points, one on the east side of Greenleaf slough and one on the west side. The grade of the approaches to said crossings not to exceed ten per cent. The Railway
