

Carl Lindstrom to C. O. Williams

Know all men by these presents, That Carl Lindstrom of Butler, Washington, is held and firmly bound unto C. O. Williams in the sum of Five hundred <\$500> Dollars, gold coin of the United States of America to be paid to the said C. O. Williams, his executor, administrators or assigns; for which payment well and truly to be made I bind myself, heirs, executors and administrators jointly and severally by these presents. Signed and Dated this 7. day of Dec. 1904.

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden obligors shall on or before the 7. day of December 1906 make, execute and deliver unto the said C. O. Williams <Provided that the said C. O. Williams shall on or before that day have paid to the said obligors the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars <\$250.00>, gold coin of the United States of America, the price by said C. O. Williams agreed to be paid therefore with interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum) a good and warranty deed to the following tract or parcel of land in Skamania County, Wash. as follows: The East half < $\frac{1}{2}$ > of the Northeast quarter < $\frac{1}{4}$ > of Section thirty-three <33> Township two <2> North Range six <6> East of Willamette Meridian, containing eighty acres more or less; Then this instrument void: otherwise in full force and virtue. The taxes on the above mentioned land to be paid when due by the aforesaid C. O. Williams.
