Know all men by these Presents that I, Harry L. Johnson, as the sole heir at law of George W. Johnson and Jennette S. Johnson, both deceased, in consideration of one \$1.00 to me paid by F. Brooke, do hereby remise, release and forever Quitclaim unto the said F. Brooke and unto his heirs and assigns all my right, title and interest in and to the following described parcel of real estate, situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

Block No. 38, being parts of Sections sixteen (16) Twenty (20) Twenty-one (21) and Twenty-nine (29) in Township Two (2) north, Range seven (7) east of the Willamette Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at the corner to said fractional sections Twenty (20) and Twenty-nine (29) on the North bank of the Columbia River, where the south line of the Southeast quarter of said Section intersects said River and running thence with the meanders of said River, North 63° East, 2 chs. and 20 lks; thence North 48° 15' East 6 chs. and 50 lks. thence North 59° 45' East, 9 chs. thence North 26° East, 3 chs. and 69 lks. thence North 8° 30' East, 12 chs. thence North 23° 30' East 2 chs. and 90 lks. thence leaving the river, North 45° West 21 chs. and 50 lks. thence North 40 chs. and 83 lks. thence South 82° 45' West, 45 chs. and 66 lks. thence South 17° 30' East, 106 lks. chs., to the Columbia River and thence with the meanders of said river North 18° 15' East 24 chs. and 86 lks., to the place of beginning, in the District of lands subject to sale at Vancouver, Washington, containing 320.21 acres excepting therefrom the interest therein heretofore conveyed to James O.
