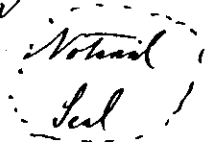

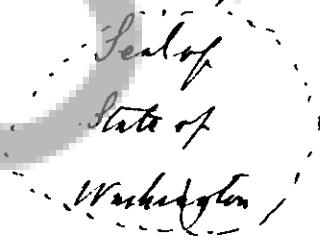
State of Washington to F. C. Yettsick
