It is further ordered by the court in pursuance of stipulation of the respective parties hereto made in open court that the claimant shall have the privilege of running a water pipe across the right of way hereby appropriated, at her own expense, at station sixteen hundred and sixty one of said railway survey and shall have a grade crossing at or near station sixteen hundred and sixty-two of said railway survey. And it appearing to the court that said petitioners Portland and Seattle Railway Company, has paid into court for the benefit of said claimant the full amount of said judgment rendered in her favor, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court that the following described strips or tracts of land in Skamania Co. Wash. are hereby appropriated to the use of the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, and the legal title thereto is hereby vested in said corporation, for any and all of its corporate purposes, to-wit: a strip of land one hundred feet in width, being fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of petitioners as the same is now located and staked out over and across the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section thirty-three, Township two north of range six east of W. M.; also a strip of land two hundred feet in width being one hundred feet wide on each side of the center line of the railroad of petitioners as the same is now staked out over and across the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section thirty-three, Township two north of range six east of Willamette Meridian.
