

taken therefrom at such point as will insure sufficient fall, said water right to be for water to fill a 3 inch pipe.

Grantees agree upon the construction of the Columbia Valley Railroad or any railroad in which grantor is in any way interested to build a switch if required by grantors to a point near and accessible to a rock quarry on said premises. Grantor shall also permit rock to be transported across or over any railroad track constructed as above described, but so as not to interfere with the operation of said railroad. Grantors also agree to make the old Bothwick road running from the old steamboat landing up the hill, through grantors remaining land, a county road 60 feet wide.

This instrument is given as a deed of correction to correct description in deed dated Nov. 29, 1905, and recorded in book 3 on page 289, deed records of Skamania Co. Wash. Dated this 2. Day of May 1906.
