


State of Washington to St. Charles Hot Springs Co.

In Consideration of One hundred twenty - three and $\frac{60}{100}$ (\$123.60) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the State of Washington does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto St. Charles Hot Springs Company, of Portland, Oregon, its successors and assigns, the following described Shore land of the second class, situated in Skamania County, Washington, to - wit:

All shore lands of the second class, owned by the State of Washington, situated in front of, adjacent to, or abutting upon the United States government meander line of lot thirteen (13), section thirty - six (36) Township three (3) North, Range seven and one half ($7\frac{1}{2}$) East, of the Willamette Meridian, and having a total frontage on said lot thirteen (13) of twenty - four and seventy - two one hundredths (24.72) linear chains as shown by the government field notes of said meander line on file in the office of the Commissioner of Public Lands, of the State of Washington. To have and to hold the said premises, with their appurtenances unto the said St. Charles Hot Springs Company, of Portland, Oregon, its successors and assigns forever.
