Inman, do hereby release, release and forever quitclaim unto the said Josiah M. Inman and unto his heirs and assigns, all my rights, title and interest in and to all that parcel of real estate, situated in Skamania County, State of Washington, to-wit:

The $\frac{1}{4}$ of the $38\frac{1}{4}$ and the $\frac{1}{2}$ of the $3W\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 35 in Twp. 3 N. of R. 7 E. W. M., also an undivided $\frac{1}{4}$ of all that certain tract or parcel of land described as follows: Beginning on the bank of the Columbia River at low water mark at the S.E. corner of the Daniel Daughman Donation claim thence North 9 chains to the N.E. corner of said claim, thence ~~south~~ west on the N boundary of said claim about 76 chains to the N.W. corner of said claim thence south on the west line of said claim 9.09 chains, thence in a straight line to a point on the bank of the Columbia River marked D. B. and F. G.
