

The court further finds that the claimant, J. Zimmerman, has no right, title or interest to it or to said premises or any part thereof and will therefore suffer no damage. The court does therefore hereby ascertain, determine and award to the claimant, Earl Burns, damages in the sum of Two hundred Dollars, to be paid to said Earl Burns to be paid into court for his benefit for the taking and injuriously affecting of said land, real estate and premises of said claimant, Earl Burns hereinafter described for the purpose of such enterprise irrespective of any benefit from any improvement proposed by said Portland and Seattle Railway Company.

Whereof, it is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court, that the claimant Earl Burns, have and recover of and from the petitioners, the sum of Two hundred Dollars as damages awarded to him for the taking and injuriously affecting of said land, real estate and premises. And it further appears to this court that said petitioners have paid into court for the benefit of the said claimant, Earl Burns, the damage awarded by the foregoing judgment.

It is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the court that the land, real estate and premises of said claimant, Earl Burns, hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby appropriated for the use of the Portland and Seattle Railway Company for any and all of its corporate purposes and the legal title thereto is hereby vested in said Portland and Seattle Railway Company for all its corporate purposes. The land, real estate and premises hereby appropriated are as follows: All of Lot Ten (10) in Block five (5) of the Town of Stevenson, Skamania County, Washington.
