

Agata Erickson to Porter Bros. & Welch.

This Indenture, made this 23^d day of May, 1906, between Mrs. Agata Erickson, party of the first part and Porter Brothers & Welch, parties of the second part, witnesses:

That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars, (\$300.) to her in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, and sell unto said party of the second part all the standing and fallen timber on the following described premises: Lots numbered 2 and 3 and the E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 26 Tps. 3 N. R. 8 E. W. 16. Said party of the first part hereby agrees to give said parties of the second part the term of five years in which to ~~now~~ remove said timber, also free rights of way for log roads, flumes, wagon roads and skates, on, over and across the timbered portion of above described land, also the privilege of piling logs, sawed timber and piling on the timbered portion of said land, also the right to pile and burn saw dust or other mill refuse on said property. Said party of first part further agrees to give said second parties the free right of way and use of the road through the Livaspine property, known as or described as that road leading from near residence of Frank Davis, in a southerly direction around west side of Wind Mountain to its intersection with the road leading to Collins & Home Valley.
