CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In conformity with the provisions of Chapter 122, Laws of Washington, in 1929, and the amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that U. S. FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE

of Portland State of Oregon has made

proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use

of the waters of an unnamed creek a tributary of Salmon River

with point or points of diversion within Sec. 10 Cor. 1

Sec. 22 Twp. 3 N. R. 10 E. W. M. under and subject to provisions contained in

Appropriation Permit No. 10124 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and

that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,

and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of

record in Volume 11 at Page 5121 on the 14th day of February 19 57

that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is May 27, 1956; that the

amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount

actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 25 cubic feet per second for fish propagation

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, as follows:

Perched on Lot 1, Sec. 22, T. 3N., R. 10 E.M.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
