Charles C. Schumard to C. A. Bell.

This Indenture, made this 26th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and six, between Charles C. Schumard, the party of the first part, and C. A. Bell, of Castle Rock, Washington, the party of the second part; Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one and 00/100 (\$1.00) Dollars gold coin of the United States of America, to me in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns the following described Quartz Lode, Esmeralda claim No 1 North, situated in St. Helens Mining District, State of Wash. County of Skamania and described as follows: Beginning at a post marked No 1 twenty five linear feet South of Discovery Post situated about two hundred feet up a deep canyon from its mouth, about one fourth mile North of the Middle Tumble River from a point three and one half miles down said river from the outlet of Spirit Lake, and about four miles North from the West shoulder of Mt St. Helens; running thence three hundred linear feet West to a post marked No 2, thence fifteen hundred linear feet North to a post marked Post No 3, thence six hundred linear feet East to a post marked Post No 5 passing at three hundred feet a post marked Post No 4, indicating center of lode; thence fifteen hundred linear feet South to a post marked post No 6, thence three hundred linear feet West to place of beginning.
