*Eva L. Reynolds to R. G. S. Willson*

This Indenture, Made the 7. Day of August in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and ninety seven between Eva L. Reynolds of the County of Wasco, State of Oregon, party of the first part and Robert Gordon Drummond Willson of Skamania Co. State of Washington, the party of the second part, Witnesses. That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars, of the United States of America, to her in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do grants, bargains, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever all that certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the south west corner of the north east quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 20 Township 3 north of Range 8 east of the Willamette Meridian, running thence North on the west line of Samuel Andrews land claim fifteen  $\frac{1}{15}$  rods, thence East forty  $\frac{1}{40}$  rods, thence south forty rods, thence west forty  $\frac{1}{40}$  rods, to said west line, thence north twenty-five  $\frac{1}{25}$  rods to the place of beginning, containing ten  $\frac{1}{10}$  acres more or less.
