

Rountree did, on the thirtieth day of December, A. D. 1901, duly enter and pay for that certain mining claim and premises, known as the Chicago Northwest Discovery, Chicago Northwest Discovery No 1 and the Chicago Northwest Discovery No 2 lots mining claims, designated by the Surveyor General as lot No. 621, embracing a portion of the unsurveyed public domain, in the St. Helens (unorganized) Mining District, in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Vancouver, and bounded, described and platted as follows, with magnetic variation twenty-one degrees and forty-eight seconds minutes east:

Beginning for the description of the Chicago Northwest Discovery Lot claim at corner No 1 from which U. S. location monument No 2 bears south nineteen degrees and fifty two minutes east seven hundred and ten and one tenth feet distant. Thence, first course, north forty-seven degrees and forty-nine minutes east three hundred feet to corner No 2 from which Discovery post bears north forty-three degrees and thirty-four minutes west seventeen feet distant. Thence, second course, north forty-seven degrees and forty-nine minutes east three hundred feet to corner No 3. Thence, third course, north forty-three degrees and thirty-four minutes west one thousand three hundred and two and four tenths feet to corner No 4. Thence, fourth course, south forty-seven degrees and forty-nine minutes west three hundred feet to corner No 5. Thence, fifth course, south forty-seven degrees and forty-nine minutes west six hundred feet to corner No 6. Thence, sixth course, south forty-three degrees and thirty-four minutes east one thousand three hundred and two and four tenths feet to corner No 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lot claim as above described extending one thousand three hundred and two and four tenths feet in length along said Chicago Northwest Discovery vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Chicago Northwest Discovery No 1 lode claim at corner No 1, identical with corner No 6 of said Chicago Northwest Discovery lot claim from which said U. S. Location monument No 2 bears south thirty-five degrees and fifteen minutes east one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three and four tenths feet distant. Thence, first course, forty-seven degrees and forty-nine minutes east three hundred and thirty-one and four tenths feet to witness corner to corner No 2; six hundred feet to corner No 3. Thence, third corner course, north forty-three degrees and thirty-four minutes west five hundred and sixty-seven and three tenths feet to corner No 4. Thence, fourth course, south forty-seven degrees and forty-nine minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which Discovery bears south forty-three degrees and thirty-four minutes east four feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No 5. Thence, fifth course, south forty-three degrees and thirty-four minutes east five hundred and sixty-seven and three tenths feet to corner No 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending five hundred and sixty-seven and three tenths feet in length along said Chicago Northwest Discovery No 1 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Chicago Northwest Discovery No 2 lode claim at corner No 1 identical with corner No 5 of said Chicago Northwest Discovery Claim No 1 from which said U. S. Location monument No 2 bears south thirty-seven degrees and six minutes east two thousand five hundred and thirty-five and eighty-eight hundredths feet distant. Thence, first course, north forty-seven degrees and forty-nine minutes east three hundred feet to a point from which Discovery post bears north forty-three degrees
