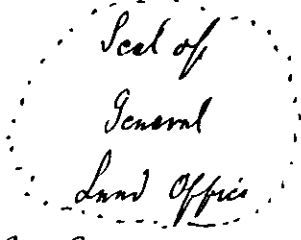

Given under my hand at the City of Washington the Twenty-fourth Day of December in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twenty eighth.
