CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 18, Laws of Washington of 1911, and a supplement thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Department of Water Resources (hereinafter).)

This is to certify that B. S. FINE and WILLIAM J. SHERIDAN
 of Portland State of Oregon, has made
 proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use
 of the waters of Little White Salmon River, a tributary of Columbia River,
 with point or points of diversion within the State of Oregon
 Sec. 26, Twp. 3, N. R. 9 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in
Appropriation Permit No. 10,343 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and
 that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,
 and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of
 record in Volume 15, at Page 7068, on the 10th day of January, 1954
 that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is July 20, 1956; that the
 amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount
 actually beneficially used and shall not exceed

18.0 cubic feet per second forthe purpose of fish culture.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the
 place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
