Henion to Hosford & Morrill

This Indenture Witnesseth that Fred N. Henion and Myrta M. Henion, husband and wife, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of eighteen hundred (\$1800.00) Dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto L.P. Hosford and Roscoe R. Morrill, parties of the second part, the following described premises, to-wit:

The fractional west half of the Northwest quarter of section six (6) in Township one (1) North of Range five (5) East of Willamette Meridian, containing 30.22 acres of land, together with tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said L.P. Hosford and Roscoe R. Morrill, their heirs and assigns forever. This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of eighteen hundred (\$1800.00) Dollars in accordance with the tenor of a certain instrument of writing of which the following is a copy, to-wit:

Portland, Oregon July 6th 1909

On or before three years after date, without grace, I promise to pay to the order of L.P. Hosford and Roscoe R. Morrill at their office in Portland, Oregon, eighteen hundred dollars in Gold Coin of the United States of America of the present standard value, with interest therein in like gold coin at the rate of six per cent per annum from date hereof until paid, for value received. Interest to be paid semi-annually and if not so paid the whole sum of both principal and interest
