Shields his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Clatsop and State of Washington: The South half of the Northwest quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section five $\frac{1}{5}$ and the south half of the northeast quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of section six $\frac{1}{6}$ all in Township one $\frac{1}{1}$ north Range five $\frac{1}{5}$ East of Willamette Meridian, containing 160 acres, Together with, all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all his estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower. To have and to hold the above described premises unto the said J. S. Shields, his heirs and assigns forever. And Hiram H. Strong junior, the grantor above named does covenant to and with J. S. Shields, the above named grantee, his heirs and assigns, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances, and that he will and his heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and forever defend the above granted premises and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever, except what reservation is made for Ditches and canals by authority of U. S. Government.
