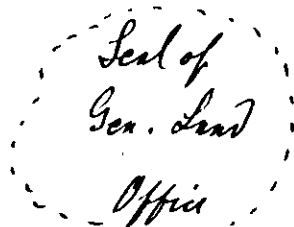


of Section twenty-one, in Township two North of Range six East of Willamette Meridian in Washington, containing forty acres,

Know Ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the aforesaid act, have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Edward B. Corrin and to his heirs, the lands last above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging unto the said Edward B. Corrin and to his heirs and assigns forever. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by authority of the United States. In Testimony Whereof I, Theodore Roosevelt, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand and, at the City of Washington, the fourteenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and four and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and twenty-ninth.
