This Indenture Made this twenty fifth day of October 1909 between Maggie E. Hamilton, the party of the first part, and Andrew Pearson, party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars gold coin of the United States to her in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, the following described tract, or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at a stone which marks the southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter, Sec. 23, Township three North of Range 10 East of Willamette Meridian, thence north for 667.5 feet to the Southwest corner of the Keeley & Dubois tract, thence east for 230 feet along the south line of said Keeley & Dubois tract, thence south for 667.5 feet to the south line of said quarter quarter, thence west for 230 feet to the point of beginning, containing three and one half acres more or less.
