**CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT**

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that **INTERNATIONAL PAPER COMPANY**

of **Longview**, State of **Washington**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of **Unnamed Spring**, a tributary of **Wind River**, with point or points of diversion within the **Government Lot 4** Sec. **27**, Twp. **3** N., R. **8 E.**, W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. **13804** issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume **19**, at Page **9338**, on the **14th** day of **May**, 1965 that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is **January 4, 1965**; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed **0.01 cubic feet per second, 1.8 acre-feet per year, during entire year for Domestic Supply.**

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

A tract of land located in the westerly portions of Lots 1 and 4 of Sec. 27, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M. and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of the county road commonly known as the Berge Road on the north line of the William M. Murphy D.L.C. #37 Notification No. 837 located in Sections 27 and 34, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M., said point being easterly 789 feet from the northwest corner of said Murphy D.L.C.; thence along the center line of the Berge Road north 18°00' east 136.5 feet; thence north 20°58' west 216.9 feet; thence north 49°15' east 325.1 feet; thence south 84°18' east 165.4 feet; thence leaving said road north 28°07' east 319.5 feet; thence north 3°31' west 333.6 feet to a point in the center of the old county road leading to Wind River; thence following the center line of said county road north 66°21' west 78.5 feet; thence north 51°43' west 185.3 feet; thence north 70°40' west 344.7 feet; thence north 47°31' west 364.9 feet; thence north 41°38' west 389.9 feet; thence north 24°49' west 175.3 feet; thence north 67°25' west 127.3 feet to a point on the west line of Lot 1 of Sec. 27, said point being 467.7 feet south of the northwest corner of said Lot 1; thence south 681.5 feet, more or less, along the west boundary of said Lot 1 to the Government Meander line on the east side of Wind River; thence southerly along said Meander line a distance of 1851 feet, more or less, to the northwest corner of said Murphy D.L.C.; thence easterly along the north boundary of the Murphy D.L.C. 789 feet to the point of beginning; containing 30.52 acres, more or less, and being situated in Lots 1 and 4 of Sec. 27, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M.

Beginning at a point marked with an iron pipe on the east boundary of the William M. Murphy D.L.C. #37 Notification No. 837 located in Sections 27 and 34, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M., said point being 1,239.0 feet north of the intersection of said east boundary with the south line of said Sec. 27; thence north 69°23' west 232.2 feet; thence south 18°18' west 188.4 feet; thence north 54°36' west 132.0 feet; thence north 47°31' west 91.7 feet; thence north 60°41' west 881.4 feet; thence north 59°38' west 123.9 feet, more or less, to a point on the Wind River Survey for the Skamania Boom Company; thence north 00°17' east 109.0 feet along said Wind River Survey to a 40" Cottonwood tree; thence north 84°28' east 89.5 feet; thence north 19°17' west 471.0 feet; thence north 28°31' east 260.0 feet; thence south 82°43' west 107.0 feet; thence north 14°15' east 193.5 feet to a point on the north boundary of said William M. Murphy D.L.C., said point being east 447.03 feet from the northwest corner of said D.L.C.; thence east along the north boundary of said D.L.C. a distance of 298 feet, more or less, to the easterly right-of-way line of the county road known as Berge Road; thence following south and southeasterly along said easterly right-of-way line of said county road a distance of 1,705 feet, more or less, to an intersection with east boundary of said D.L.C.; thence south along the east boundary of said D.L.C. a distance of 222 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; containing 23.3 acres, more or less, and all being situated in Sec. 27, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
