CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that STATE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION
of Olympia, State of Washington, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use
of the waters of an unnamed spring, a tributary of -,
with point or points of diversion within the Gov't. Lot 9 and Elizabeth Snooks D.L.C. No. 37
Sec. 25, Twp. 2 N., R. 6 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in
appropriation Permit No. 14550 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and
that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,
and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of
record in Volume 20, at Page 9892, on the 27th day of February, 19 67
that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is August 11, 1966; that the
amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount
actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second, 20 acre-feet per year,
during entire year for domestic supply for public park

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the
place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: That part of Beacon Rock State Park
in Secs. 25, 26, and 36, T. 2 N., R. 6 E.W.M. described as follows: IN Sec. 25: Beginning
at a point on the east line of the Elizabeth Snooks D.L.C. No. 37 600 feet south of the
northeast corner thereof; thence north 42°43' west to a point on the northerly Right of
Way line of P.S.H. No. 8 and the initial point of this description; thence continue north
42°43' west to north line of said D.L.C.; thence west 3670 feet, more or less to northwest
corner of said D.L.C.; thence south along west line of said D.L.C. to the northerly Right
of Way of the S.P. and S. Railway; thence northeasterly along said Right of Way to a
point 1000 feet west of the eastline of said D.L.C.; thence north to a point on the north
Right of Way line of said P.S.H. No. 8; thence northerly along said Right of Way to the
point of beginning; AND: Gov't. Lots 8, 9, and 10; AND: The W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Gov't. Lot 11; AND: That
part of Gov't. Lot 5 lying easterly of Right of Way of S.P. and S. Railway and all shore-
lands in front of, and abutting, this tract; and the east 132 feet of said Gov't. Lot 5; AND:
In Sec. 36: That portion of Gov't. Lot 3 lying northerly and easterly of the center of Little
Creek and all shorelands in front of, and abutting, this tract; AND: In Sec. 26: Commencing
at the east quarter corner of said section; thence west 405 feet; thence south 23°40' east
249.9 feet more or less; thence south 60°20' west 137.7 feet more or less to the east
boundary of the Kuffler County Road; thence southeasterly along said east boundary to its
intersection with the center line of the Old State Highway, a distance of 250 feet, more
or less; thence northeasterly along said center line to its intersection with the east
line of said Section; thence north to point of beginning; AND: The E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
