CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources hereunder.)

This is to certify that L. H. PIERCE AUTO SERVICE
 of North Bonneville, State of Washington, has made
 proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use
 of the waters of Hardy Creek, a tributary of Columbia River,
 with point or points of diversion within the Elizabeth Snooks D.L.C.
 Sec. 25, Twp. 2 N., R. 6 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in
 Appropriation Permit No. 11237 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and
 that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,
 and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of
 record in Volume 17, at Page 8203, on the 14th day of August, 1961;
 that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is November 19, 1958; that the
 amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount
 actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.50 of a cubic foot per second, 100 acre-feet
per year for the irrigation of 50 acres.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the
 place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner
 of the Elizabeth Snooks D.L.C. in Sec. 25, T. 2 N., R. 6 E., W.M., thence south 600
 feet; thence north 42° west 816 feet; thence south 89° east 554 feet to the point of
 beginning; excepting therefrom three acres deeded to S. M. Barnard Lumber Co.,
 recorded in Book 29 at page 292, records of said county.

Also, beginning at a point 1.27 chains west of the northeast corner of Sec. 25 in the
 aforesaid township and range; thence east 77 chains; thence south 22° east 11.40
 chains to the north bank of Hamilton Creek; thence with the meanders of said creek
 and the Columbia River downstream to a point due south of the point of beginning;
 thence north 57.40 chains to the point of beginning: being the E. G. Hardy D.L.C.
 No. 842. Excepting therefrom 1.93 acres deeded to S. P. & S. Ry. Co., recorded in
 Book Z at page 9, and also excepting therefrom 8 acres deeded to S. M. Barnard
 Lumber Co., recorded in Book 29 at page 292, records of said county.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of
 use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
