that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 21, at Page 10336, on the 21st day of May, 1968

that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is February 20, 1968; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount

actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, 1 acre-foot per year continuously during the entire year for domestic supply for one unit; and 0.01 cubic foot per second, 2 acre-feet per year, from May 1 to October 1 each year for irrigation of 1 acre.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Beginning at a point on the northerly right-of-way line of State Highway No. 8, 145.2 feet south and 286.7 feet east of the northwest corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 19, T. 2 N., R. 7 E.W.M.; thence north 322.3 feet; thence east 164.3 feet; thence south 208.2 feet to the said northerly right-of-way line; thence south 55°13' west 200 feet along said right-of-way line to place of beginning.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.

This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water provided in Section 18, Chapter 233, Laws of 1967.
