## CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that SKAMANIA COUNTY

of Stevenson, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Canyon Creek, with point or points of diversion within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 5, Twp. 1 N., R. 5 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 14546 issued by the Department of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 21, at Page 10338, on the 21st day of May, 1968, that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is June 21, 1966; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second, 1 acre-foot per year, continuously each year for domestic supply for county park.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Beginning at a point 65.3 feet south of the northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 5, T. 1 N., R. 5 E. W.M.; thence south 594.7 feet to the center of said Sec. 5; thence west 660 feet; thence north 817.6 feet to Old State Road No. 8; thence southeasterly to the point of beginning.



The use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.

This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in Section 18, Chapter 233, Laws of 1967.
