CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that WILLIAM and EDITH J. BRANDT
of Cook, State of Washington, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use
of the waters of unnamed spring and stream, a tributary of Columbia River,
with point or points of diversion within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Sec. 27, Twp. 3 N., R. 9 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in
appropriation Permit No. 14842 issued by the Department of Water Resources, and
that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington,
and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Water Resources of Washington and entered of
record in Volume 21, at Page 10423, on the 16th day of August, 19 68
that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is February 7, 1967; that the
amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount
actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second, 8 acre-feet per
year, from May 1 through October 31 each year, for irrigation of 4 acres, and for
fire protection as needed

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the
place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Within Sec. 27: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; LESS the north 500 feet thereof; AND LESS that
tract of land deeded to School District as described on page 233 of Book "P" of
Deeds;

AND Within Sec. 34: Lots 12 through 18 of Block 5 and all of Block 4 within the
Plat of Original Townsite of Cook, being within Government Lot 3;
LESS easements;

All within T. 3 N., R. 9 E.W.M.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.

This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water
as provided in Section 18, Chapter 233, Laws of 1967.
