# **CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT**

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that JOHN H. KOCK

of Cook, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Whiskey Spring, a tributary of Little White Salmon River, with point or points of diversion within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 26, Twp. 4 N., R. 9 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in Appropriation Permit No. 12389 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered of record in Volume 17, at Page 8267, on the 17th day of October, 1961, that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is March 16, 1961; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 of a cubic foot per second, for domestic supply; and 0.05 of a cubic foot per second, 10 acre-feet per year, for the irrigation of 5 acres.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
