

CERTIFICATE OF CHANGE OF POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto and rules thereunder, of the State Director of Water Resources.


THIS IS TO CERTIFY That Northern Pacific Railway Company of Seattle, Washington, has complied with all of the requirements of the Revised Code of Washington 90.03.380 and is hereby granted the right to change the point of diversion of 0.25 cubic foot per second, of the waters of an unnamed stream, tributary of Swift Reservoir (Lewis River), as granted in Surface Water Certificate No. 10573.

That the use of such water is for the purpose of community domestic supply and that the company had diverted water from said stream at a point erroneously described as being situated in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 7 North, Range 6 East W.M.

That the company has changed the above point of diversion to a point correctly described as situated in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 27, T. 7 N., R. 6 E.W.M., Skamania County, Washington, such point being approximately 300 feet west and 500 feet north of the southeast corner of Sec. 27.
