CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendment thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That W. J. CRAINE

of Vancouver, Washington, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters
of the State of Washington from Washougal River
a tributary of Columbia River, with point of diversion within

S.W. 1/4 Sec. 34, Twp. 2 N., R. 5 E.

Sec. 34, Twp. 2 N., R. 5 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of domestic supply
under and specifically subject

to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 15441 issued by the
Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance
with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of
record in Volume 23, at Page 11232 that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
July 25, 1968; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for

the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed
0.01 cubic feet per second, 1 acre-foot per year, continuously during the entire
year for domestic supply.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

Within the W.S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 34, T. 4 N., R. 5 E. W.M.: beginning at a point in the
centerline of the Washougal River at a point 500 feet east of the west line of said
section; thence north 435 feet; thence east 100 feet; thence south to said
centerline; thence westerly along said center line to point of beginning.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.
This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as
provided in RCW 90.14.180.
