CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That

ROY V. and LILLIAN I. TESTY

of Shamana, Washington, has made
 proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters
 of the State of Washington from an unnamed stream
 a tributary of _____, with point of diversion within SW 1/4 SE 1/4

Sec. 26, Twp. 2 N., R. 6 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of irrigation and domestic
 supply _____ under and specifically subject
 to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 15033 issued by the
 Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance
 with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of
 record in Volume 23, at Page 11320, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
 October 4, 1967, that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for
 the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03
 cubic foot per second, 4 acre-feet per year, each year during irrigation season, for
 irrigation of 2 acres; and 1 acre-foot per year, during entire year, for domestic supply.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

Beginning at a point 859.4 feet north and 30 feet east of the southwest corner of SE 1/4 SE 1/4
 of Sec. 26, T. 2 N., R. 6 E.W.M.; thence south 286.4 feet; thence east 50 feet; thence
 south 30 feet; thence east 261.5 feet, more or less; thence north 17°47' west; 401.5 feet;
 thence south 70°46' west 200 feet to the point of beginning; LESS that part thereof lying
 northerly of a line bearing north 70°46' east from a point 175.74 feet south of the point
 of beginning; AND
 Beginning at a point 543 feet north and 311.5 feet east of the said southwest corner of
 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 26; thence east 75 feet to the westerly right of way of the former State
 Highway No. 8; thence southeasterly along said right of way to intersection of the northerly
 right of way of State Highway 2 (SR 830) as established on 16 March, 1927; thence south-
 westerly along said right of way 200 feet, more or less, to a point lying south 7°30' east
 from the point of beginning; thence continuing southwesterly along said right of way 100
 feet; thence north 7°30' west 400 feet, more or less, to the south line of the tract described
 above; thence east to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.
 This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as
 provided in RCW 90.14.180.

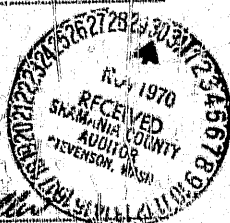
