

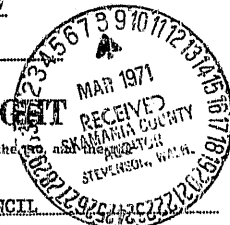

## CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendment thereto, and regulations of the Department of Ecology.)



THIS IS TO CERTIFY That COLUMBIA RIVER GIRL SCOUT COUNCIL

of Portland, Oregon, has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters  
of the State of Washington from an unnamed spring  
a tributary of —, with point of diversion within SESESE

Sec. 24 Twp. 3 N., R. 3 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of domestic supply  
for a camp under and specifically subject  
to provisions contained in Appropriation Permit No. 15324 issued by the  
Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance  
with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of  
record in Volume 23, at Page 11420, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
February 7, 1968; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for  
the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.23  
cubic foot per second, 8.4 acre-feet per year, during entire year, for domestic supply.  
for Girl Scout Camp.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and S $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec. 25, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M.; LESS beginning at the south quarter corner  
of said section; thence west 1320 feet; thence north 330 feet to the south side of Rock  
Creek and Collins Road; thence northeasterly 690 feet along the south line of said road;  
thence southeasterly 450 feet along south line of said road to a point 330 feet north and  
180 feet west from said south quarter corner; thence east 40 feet to a point on the north  
line of said road; thence southeasterly along said north line to a point on the north-  
south section centerline; thence south 110 feet to point of beginning; AND LESS the north  
825 feet of the west 478.5 feet of said S $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec. 25.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.

This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as  
provided in RCW 90.14.180.
