(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Forestry.)

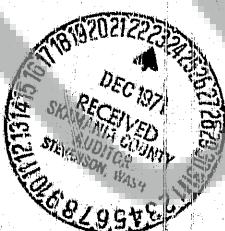

proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters
of the State of Washington from _____ Rock Creek _____
a tributary of _____ Little White Salmon River _____ with point of diversion within _____ SW-NE-SE-1

Sec. 10, Chap. 3, N. R. 9 E., W. 3 E. for the purpose(s) of irrigation and fire protection under and specifically subject to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 16721 issued by the Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of record in Volume 24, at Page 11702; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 2, 1971; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, 4 acre-feet per year, from April 1 through November 15 each year, for irrigation of 2 acres; and as needed each year for fire protection.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

That portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 11, T. 3 N., R. 9 E.W.M., described as follows:
beginning at the northeast corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 11; thence west 330 feet;
thence south 148.5 feet; thence west 42.5 feet; thence south 100 feet; thence west 26 feet;
thence south 411.5 feet, more or less, to the south line of said Sec. 11; thence east
346.5 feet; thence north 660 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.
