of Corvallis, Oregon, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters
of the State of Washington from unnamed springs (Home Spring)
a tributary of Canyon Creek with point of diversion within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the fractional
UNKNOWN
Sec 4 Twp 1 N., R. 5 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of domestic supply
under and specifically subject
to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 16785 issued by the
Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance
with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of
record in Volume 24 at Page 11846; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
February 24, 1971; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed for
the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01
cubic foot per second, 1 acre-foot per year, during entire year, for domestic supply.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

Within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the fractional NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 4, T. 1 N., R. 5 E.W.M.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.
This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as
provided in RCW 90.14.180.


