CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90.03, Laws of Washington for 1971, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology.

This is to Certify That W. O. WHITMAN of Tacoma, Washington; STANLEY LLOYD of Port Angeles, Oregon, and ROBERT MARTIN of Longview, Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters of the State of Washington from an unnamed stream a tributary of North Fork Toutle River, with point of diversion within SE 1/4 Sec. 16

Sec. 16 Twp. 9 N., R. 5 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of domestic supply under and specifically subject to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 16679 issued by the Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of record in Volume S 2-00011 C at Page 1; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 29, 1970; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second, 1/2 acre-feet per year, during entire year for domestic supply.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:
Lots 1, 8, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 of Block 1 of the plat of Lange's Homestead, within NE 1/4 of Sec. 16, T. 9 N., R. 5 E., W.M.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.
This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
