CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117 Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendment thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That GLEN E. KIDNER

of Stevenson, Washington, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters
of the State of Washington from Collins Creek
a tributary of Columbia River, with point of diversion within NW 1/4 SW 1/4

Sec. 31, Twp. 3 N., R. 9 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of domestic supply
under and specifically subject
to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 16769 issued by the
Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance
with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of
record in Volume S 2-00087 C at Page 1 that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
May 5, 1970; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for
the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed
0.01 cubic feet per second, 1 acre-foot per year, during entire year
for domestic supply.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

That part of the Jas. M. Findley D.L.C. No. 37, within Sec. 31, T. 3 N.
Range 9 E.W.M., described as follows: beginning at the intersection
of Collins Creek and the northerly right of way line of the U. S.
Highway No. 830, (State Highway No. 5); thence south 80° west along
said northerly right of way line 280 feet; thence north 2°30' west
755 feet; thence north 80° east 250 feet, more or less, to the center
line of said Collins Creek; thence along said center line of Collins
Creek southerly to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.
This right of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as
provided in RCW 90.03.130.
