THIS IS TO CERTIFY That CLAIR E. AND THELMA E. FANNING

 proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters
 of the State of Washington from unnamed spring
 a tributary of Washougal River, with point of diversion within NW 1/4 Sec. 27
Sec. 27, Twp. 2 N., R. 5 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of domestic supply
under and specifically subject
 to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. S 2-00062 P issued by the
 Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said water has been perfected in accordance
 with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of
S 2-00062 C
 record in Volume _____, at Page 1; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
November 5, 1971; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for
 the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed
0.01 cubic feet per second, 1 acre-foot per year, during entire year for domestic
supply.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

The part of the E 1/2 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 27, T. 2 N., R. 5 E.W.M., lying north-
 westerly of the Washougal River Road as presently exists.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.
 This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as
 provided in RCW 90.14.180.
