is, pursuant to the Report of Examination which has been accepted by the applicant, hereby granted a permit to appropriate the following described public surface waters of the State of Washington, subject to existing rights and to the limitations and provisions set out herein.

Priority date of this permit is August 24, 1970Source of the proposed appropriation is Cedar Creek
tributary of Panther CreekThe quantity of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be beneficially applied and not to exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second, 1/2 acre-feet per year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, to be used for the following purposes: domestic supply, as more definitely set out below.The approximate point(s) of diversion is/are 700 feet north and 1190 feet east of the south quarter corner of Sec. 25,being within SW 1/4 SE 1/4of Sec. 25, Twp. 4 N., Rge. 7 1/2 E. W.M., Skamania County.

The use, or uses, to which water is to be applied:

Domestic/municipal supply. 0.01 cubic feet per second, 1/2 acre-feet per year, during entire year.Irrigation: 0.01 cubic feet per second, 1/2 acre-feet per year from to each year, for irrigation of acres.Other use(s) ; 0.01 cubic feet per second, 1/2 acre-feet per year, from to each year.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF LANES UPON WHICH THIS WATER IS TO BE USED:

The east 165 feet of the west 990 feet of SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 25, T. 4 N. R. 7 1/2 E.W.M., LESS roads.

FOR POWER:cubic feet per second continuously each year. Total power to be developed.....theoretical horse power. Total fall to be utilized.....feet.

ADDITIONAL LIMITATIONS AND PROVISIONS: Permittee shall construct and maintain at his own expense a weir, or other suitable device, for measurement of water related to this appropriation, as required by the Department of Ecology.

Diversion intake shall be tightly screened at all times with wire mesh having openings with dimensions not greater than .125 (1/8) inch.

Nothing in this permit shall be construed as excusing the permittee from compliance with any applicable federal, state, or local statutes, ordinance, or regulations including those administered by local agencies under the Shoreline Management Act of 1971.
