CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendment thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That CARL J. AND LYDIA L. HEDENCREN
 of Vancouver, Washington, has made
 proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters
 of the State of Washington from Trout Creek
 a tributary of Wind River, with point of diversion within NE 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 4 N., R. 7 E.
 Sec. 26, Twp. 4 N., R. 7 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of domestic supply and
fire protection under and specifically subject
 to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. S 2-00071 P issued by the
 Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance
 with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of
 record in Volume _____, at Page S 2-00071 C; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
August 6, 1971, that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for
 the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed
0.01 cubic foot per second, 1/2 acre-foot per year, during entire year for domestic
supply; as needed for fire protection.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is a riparian is as follows:

Beginning at a point 765 feet east and 205 feet north of the southwest corner of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 26, T. 4 N., R. 7 E.W.M.; thence south 88°00' west 120 feet; thence north 200 feet, more or less, to the center of Trout Creek; thence in an easterly direction following the center of Trout Creek to a point north of the point of beginning; thence south 174 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; AND beginning at a point 765 feet east of the said southwest corner of the NE 1/4 SW 1/4; thence north 190 feet; thence south 77°09' east 120 feet; thence south to intersection with the south line of the said NE 1/4 SW 1/4; thence west along said south line to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.
 This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
