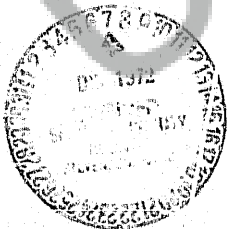
## CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendment thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That P.U.D. No. 1, SKAMANIA COUNTY  
 of Stevenson, Washington, has made  
 proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters  
 of the State of Washington from Bear Creek  
 a tributary of Wind River, with point of diversion within NE 1/4  
 Sec. 33, Twp. 4 N, R. 8 E, W.M. for the purpose of community domestic supply  
 under and specifically subject  
 to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 8134 issued by the  
 Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance  
 with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of  
 record in Volume S2-00400 C, at Page 1; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
 December 12, 1951; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for  
 the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed  
 2.0 cubic feet per second, 350 acre-feet per year, during entire year for  
 community domestic supply.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

Area served by Skamania County P.U.D. No. 1 within T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the land or place  
 of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.  
 This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as  
 provided in RCW 90.14.180.
