CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendment thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That CLIFTON AND ETHEL C. DIAL
 of Portland, Oregon, has made
 proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters
 of the State of Washington from Trout Creek
 a tributary of Wind River, with point of diversion within S¹/4 NE¹/4 SW¹/4
 Sec. 26, Twp. 4 N., R. 7 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of stockwater and
domestic supply under and specifically subject
 to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. S 2-20059 P issued by the
 Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance
 with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of
 record in Volume _____, at Page 1; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
March 7, 1972; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for
 the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed
0.01 cubic feet per second, 0.5 acre-foot per year, during entire year for
stockwater and domestic supply.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

That portion of S¹/4 NE¹/4 SW¹/4 and E¹/4 NE¹/4 SW¹/4 of Sec. 26, T. 4 N., R. 7 E.W.M. lying north
 and east of the center of Trout Creek and south and east of the county road right of way.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.

This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for reuse of water as
 provided in RCW 90.14.180.
