to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 16777 issued by the
Department of Ecology, and said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance

with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of
record in Volume _____, at Page 1; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

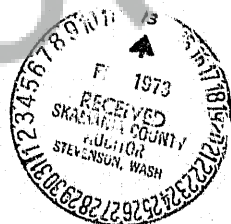
March 24, 1971; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for
the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed

0.01 cubic feet per second, 1 acre-foot per year, during entire year for domestic supply;

0.09 cubic feet per second, 20 acre-feet per year from April 1 through November 1 each
year, for irrigation of 10 acres.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 11, T. 3 N., R. 9 E.W.M.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described, except as provided in 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.

This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment of use of water as
provided in RCW 90.14.180.
