Section 35, Township 2 North, Range 6 E.W.M.

 described real property situated in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit:

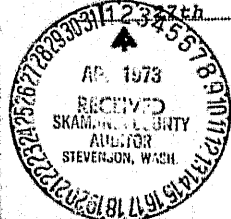
