Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance
with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of

record in Volume _____, at Page _____; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

March 9, 1971; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for
the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed

0.04 cubic feet per second; 1 acre-foot per year, during entire year for domestic supply;
14.4 acre-feet per year from May 1 through October 31 each year, for irrigation of
8 acres; and 1 acre-foot continuously each year for stockwater; and fire protection
as needed each year.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4, SE 1/4 of Sec. 1, T. 3 N., R. 9 E. W.M., LESS rights of way.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.

This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to reclamation for purposes of RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.
