## CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendment thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That DONALD M. AND JENNIE K. GOODE, et al  
 of Portland, Oregon, has made  
 proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters  
 of the State of Washington from an unnamed stream  
 a tributary of Washougal River, with point of diversion within Skamania  
 Sec. 34, Twp. 2 N., R. 5 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of group domestic supply  
 under and specifically subject  
 to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. S 2-20531 P issued by the  
 Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance  
 with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of  
 record in Volume \_\_\_\_\_, at Page S 2-20531 C; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
October 2, 1972; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for  
 the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed  
0.05 cubic feet per second, 5 acre-feet per year, during entire year for group  
domestic supply.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place  
 of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.

This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as  
 provided in RCW 90.14.180.

GORDON W. AND RUTH GOODE PROPERTY:

Beginning at a point on the west boundary line of Sec. 34, T. 2 N., R. 5 E.W.M., and the intersection with the center line of the channel of Washougal River; thence easterly along said center line to a point 600 feet east of the west boundary line of said Sec. 34, the true point of beginning; thence north 435 feet, more or less, to a point on the center line of a private road; thence easterly along said center line to a point 700 feet east of the west boundary line of said Sec. 34; thence south 435 feet, more or less, to a point in the center of said Washougal River; thence westerly 100 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning;

LESS that part thereof beginning at the northeast corner of said above described lot: thence south        feet; thence west 45 feet; thence north 230 feet; thence east to the place of beginning.

DONALD AND JENNIE K. GOODE PROPERTY:

Beginning at a point on the west line of Sec. 34, T. 2 N., R. 5 E.W.M., and the center line of the channel of Washougal River; thence easterly along said center line to a point 803 feet east of the west line of Sec. 34, and the true point of beginning; thence north 435 feet, more or less, to a point in the center of a private road; thence easterly along said center line to a point 900 feet east of the west boundary line of said Sec. 34; thence south 435 feet, more or less, to a point in the center of said Washougal River, said point being 900 feet east of the west boundary line of said Sec. 34; thence westerly 100 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

RENE F. AND NANA M. BERTHEAU PROPERTY:

A tract of land located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 34, T. 2 N., R. 5 E.W.M., more particularly described as follows: beginning at a point marking the intersection of the channel of the Washougal River with the west boundary line of the said Sec. 34; thence following said channel of the Washougal River easterly to a point 800 feet east of the west line of the said Sec. 34, the true point of beginning; thence north 435 feet, more or less, to a point in the center of a private road; thence westerly following the center of said private road to a point 655 feet east of the west line of the said Sec. 34; thence south 230 feet; thence east 45 feet; thence south 205 feet, more or less, to the channel of the Washougal River, said point being 700 feet east of the west line of the said Sec. 34; thence easterly following the channel of the Washougal River to the true point of beginning.

CHARLES V. AND ESTELIA F. FLETCHER PROPERTY:

Beginning at a point on the west line of Sec. 34, T. 2 N., R. 5 E.W.M., and the center line of the channel of Washougal River; thence easterly along said center line to a point 900 feet east of said west line of Sec. 34, the true place of beginning of the tract herein described; thence north 435 feet, more or less, to a point on the center line of a private road; thence easterly along said center line of said private road to a point 1030 feet east of said west boundary line of said Sec. 34; thence south 435 feet, more or less, to a point in center of said Washougal River; thence westerly following the center of the channel of said Washougal River 100 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

HERBERT AND VERA E. KIORS PROPERTY:

Beginning at a point marked by a  $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch iron pipe located 400 feet south of the northwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec. 34, T. 2 N., R. 5 E.W.M.; thence east 250 feet, more or less, to the center of the channel of the Washougal River, the line passing through a  $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch iron pipe at the top and edge of the steep bank of the river; thence south-southwesterly along the said center of the channel to a point on an east-west line located 150 feet south of the point of beginning; thence west 170 feet, more or less, through a 1-inch steel rod at the top of the bank overlooking the river to a  $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch iron pipe located 550 feet south of the northwest corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 34; thence north, along the center line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Sec. 34, 100 feet to a 1-inch steel rod; thence north 80° west 65.5 feet, more or less, to a 1-inch steel rod located at the edge of the road; thence north-northeasterly along the edge of the road 49 feet, more or less, to a  $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch iron pipe located west of the point of beginning; thence east 40 feet, more or less, to the  $\frac{1}{2}$ -inch iron pipe marking the point of beginning.
