

CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 170, Laws of Washington, 1972, and amendment thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department)

This is to certify that STANLEY J. MITERof Stevenson, Washington,is granted a right to the use of the public surface waters of the State of Washington from unnamed streama tributary of Kanaka Creek, with point of diversion within Lot 1 of theStevenson Park Addition.Sec. 35, Twp. 3, R. 1 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of irrigationwhich and specifically subject
to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. S-2-20262 E issued by the
Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance
with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of
record in Volume —, at Page —, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
June 1, 1972; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for
the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed
0.01 cubic feet per second, 1.4 acre-feet per year, from May 1 to Oct 31 each
year, for irrigation of 1/2 acre.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

That portion of Lot 1 of the plat of Stevenson Park Addition described as follows:
commencing at a point 300 feet south of the north line of the said Lot 1, and 125 feet
west of the west line of Strawberry Road; thence north 82 feet to the true point of
beginning; thence south 85° west to intersection with the center of Kanaka Creek; thence
following the center of Kanaka Creek in a northwesterly direction to a point in the center
of Kanaka Creek marked by a one inch iron pipe driven in the ground 150 feet south of the
north line of the said Lot 1; thence east along a line parallel to and 150 feet southerly
of the north line of the said Lot 1 to a point due north of the true point of beginning;
thence south 68 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.04.280 and 90.04.290.This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to reclassification for water supply


THIS IS TO CERTIFY THAT STANLEY J. MEYER

of Stevenson, Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters of the State of Washington from unnamed stream a tributary of Kanaka Creek, with point of diversion within Lot 1 of the plat of Stevenson Park Addition.

Sec. 36, Twp. 3 N., R. 7 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of irrigation under and specifically subject to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. S-20262 C issued by the Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of record in Volume _____ at Page _____; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from a

June 1, 1972; that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.01 cubic feet per second, 1.4 acre-feet per year, from May 1 to October 31 each year, for irrigation of 1/2 acre.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows: That portion of Lot 1 of the plat of Stevenson Park Addition described as follows: commencing at a point 300 feet south of the north line of the said Lot 1, and 165 feet west of the west line of Strawberry Road; thence north 82 feet to the true point of beginning; thence south 85° west to intersection with the center of Kanaka Creek; thence following the center of Kanaka Creek in a northwesterly direction to a point in the center of Kanaka Creek marked by a one inch iron pipe driven in the ground 150 feet south of the north line of the said Lot 1; thence east along a line parallel to and 150 feet southerly of the north line of the said Lot 1 to a point due north of the true point of beginning; thence south 82 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.



The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.
This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for misuse of water as provided in RCW 90.14.180.
