supply; and 0.015 cubic feet per second, 3.4 acre-feet per year from May 1 to September 30
each year, for irrigation of 2 acres.

That portion of the NW 1/4, Sec. 29, T. 3 N., R. 8 E.W.M., described as follows:
beginning at the southwest corner of the NW 1/4 of said Sec. 29; thence east 330 feet;
thence north 330 feet; thence east 330 feet; thence north to intersection with
Secondary State Highway No. 8-U; thence following said road in a southwesterly
direction to intersection with the west line of the NW 1/4 of said Sec. 29; thence
south to the point of beginning; LESS road.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.330 and 90.03.390.
This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for use of water as
provided in RCW 90.03.390.

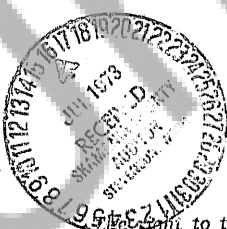
