CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendment thereto, and the rules and regulations of the Department of Ecology.)

THIS IS TO CERTIFY That ROBERTSON H. AND DORIS J. GALVIN
 of Washougal, Washington, has made
 proof to the satisfaction of the Department of Ecology of a right to the use of the public surface waters
 of the State of Washington from Washougal River
 a tributary of Columbia River, with point of diversion within Fractional NE 1/4
Sec. 6, Twp. 1 N., R. 5 E., W.M. for the purpose(s) of domestic supply
 under and specifically subject
 to provisions contained in appropriation Permit No. 16822 issued by the
 Department of Ecology, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance
 with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the Department of Ecology and entered of
 record in Volume -, at Page /; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
April 28, 1971, that the quantity of water under the right hereby confirmed, for
 the aforesaid purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed
0.01 cubic feet per second, 1 acre-foot per year, during entire year for domestic
supply.

A description of the lands to which such surface water right is appurtenant is as follows:

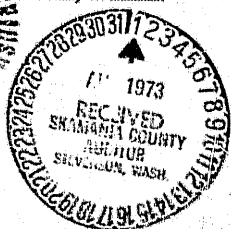
That portion of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 6, T. 1 N., R. 5 E.W.M., more particularly described
 as follows: Beginning at a point on the center line of the State Highway at the low
 water mark on the east bank of the Washougal River, which point is south 89°31' west
 857.5 feet and south 8°34' west 122.77 feet from the northeast corner of said Sec. 6;
 thence south 122.27 feet and west 564.43 feet to an iron bar which marks the initial
 point of the tract hereby described; thence north 87°26' west 70.00 feet; thence north
 2°34' east 115.62 feet to the low water line of the Washougal River; thence south
 87°26' east along said low water line 88.00 feet; thence south 11°25' west 117.01
 feet to the initial point of the tract hereby described.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place
 of use herein described, except as provided in RCW 90.03.380 and 90.03.390.

This certificate of surface water right is specifically subject to relinquishment for nonuse of water as
 provided in RCW 90.14.180.
