

AFFIDAVIT

William E. Warren, being first duly sworn on oath deposes and says as follows:

That the affiant is a resident of Skamania County and is personally acquainted with Blanche A. Stevenson whose address is Route 2, Box 333, Washougal, Washington, and who is the owner of a tract of real property situated in Sections 9, 10, 15, and 16, Township 1 North, Range 5 E. W. M., in Skamania County, Washington.

That the affiant has resided in Skamania County, Washington, for 52 years and is personally acquainted with the use which has been made of the above described real property by Mrs. Stevenson and her husband, Miles B. Stevenson, now deceased; that the affiant knows of his own knowledge that Mrs. Stevenson and her husband have appropriated and used public waters of the State of Washington beneficially on the above described real property for domestic purposes, for the watering of cattle and for irrigation continuously and under claim of right at all times since 1915; and the affiant further states that the public waters so appropriated are now in use for the aforesaid purposes by Mrs. Stevenson.

That the public waters which are the subject of this affidavit arise from an unnamed spring located on the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 9, Township 1 North, Range 5 E. W. M., the same being a portion of a tract of land owned by Phillip Kerner. The water arising from said spring flows in a water-course crossing Primary State Highway No. 8 at milepost 25/63.

This affidavit is made for the purpose of making a public record of the appropriation according to law by Blanche A. Stevenson and her husband of the public waters described above in this affidavit.
